
Look in their pasts and find all the CONSPIRED slayings see (Crusades, Huguenots, -which I myself descend, etc.) These are all nations that still use physi-



Leonard Black who is currently serving a 30year Federal Sentence at FCI Ft Dix Nj for robbery and a list of other crimes is dedicated to not only changing his life, but the lives of others. A true fighter, who just defeated Cancer is now fighting for his freedom to show the world that anyone can change over time.

"Changes Over Time"

Change is to alter, transform, adjust, modify, or just plain old do something different. A change occurs every second of the day. Some changes happen so fast that you don't even realize there was a change. Changes can be for the better or the worse depending on how you view them. Are you afraid of change? If so, why? Whether you know it or not or even whether you care or not, change is inevitable, it is going to happen. We as a people are always questioning the actions of others when we see or hear something that is out of the ordinary. But the thing we don't realize is that those out of the ordinary things are just something different. I have heard numerous sayings that state, "If it aint broke don't fix it," or "Don't go away from something that is working" or "Let's stick to the same things that got us here" just to name a few. Now I don't know about you, but I think that if you stick to the same program, then eventually it is going to stop working for you or some obstacle is going to get in your way that forces you to alter what you are doing. Look at the game of chess for a second or any sport or anything for that matter that has an effect in your life. Do you see the similarities? What do they have in common? Now, because of some very technical problems that I am going through at the present time I am not able to be there in person, but I would like for each and every one of you to pay close attention to what I havt to say. I am presently inside the belly of a beast because of bad choices and unless something gives in the Federal Laws or a Time Reduction Motion (for the right thing) is granted I will be in here until 2030. That's right, you heard it correctly, "2030!" It is not 2019 which means that my present out date is still more than 12 years away. Think for a moment, are you trying to fit in or survive? I fit in to both categories. That's right; you heard it correctly, I said "I fit in to both categories."

With me everything started out as survival tactics, schemes, and games. When there wasn't enough to eat, I stole something to eat. When my mother didn't have enough money to give me for clothes and field trips, I found a way to get some cash to do what I wanted and get what I needed. I made sure that I was going to survive. After a while, I began to do things just to match up with people who had stuff. I kept my grades up because I wanted to play sports and I even graduated from high school.

It took a while for me to get popped off by the cops. I thought for a long time that I would never get knocked. But that day came when I turned 17. I didn't go to jail, but they put me on probation because my grades at school were pretty good. Plus, it was my first time. Every other time I got close to getting into trouble, I ran and got away. Getting caught was not something I had planned on and even though I didn't get locked up, I quickly realized that probation was some straight garbage, but I made it off paper in a year. 


